Orientation for Newly-Funded Sites

- A signed copy of the grantee's Sub-grantee agreement is sent to the grantee's program contact.
- A check for the current year's grant award amount will be sent to the school district/BOCES **business office.**
- A private, non-parochial school, charter school, facility or alternative school award will be sent to the school, unless otherwise requested by the school.
- The assigned grant code is 3183.
- A mid-year report is required for all grantees to complete online, due the last working day of January.
- An online final report and continuation application is due to CDE no later than the last working day of July.
- Budgets and strategies may be revised in consultation with CDE consultants Cindy Wakefield or Judith Martinez. This will require submitting a brief paragraph of explanation and an updated electronic budget.
- Funds that are designated for a summer program or materials/services purchased should be paid prior to submitting the continuation application in June.
- Any unobligated funds will be subtracted from the next year's requested funds.
- The grant fund amount will be reduced by 25% of the highest award in the third year and 50% of the highest award in the fourth
