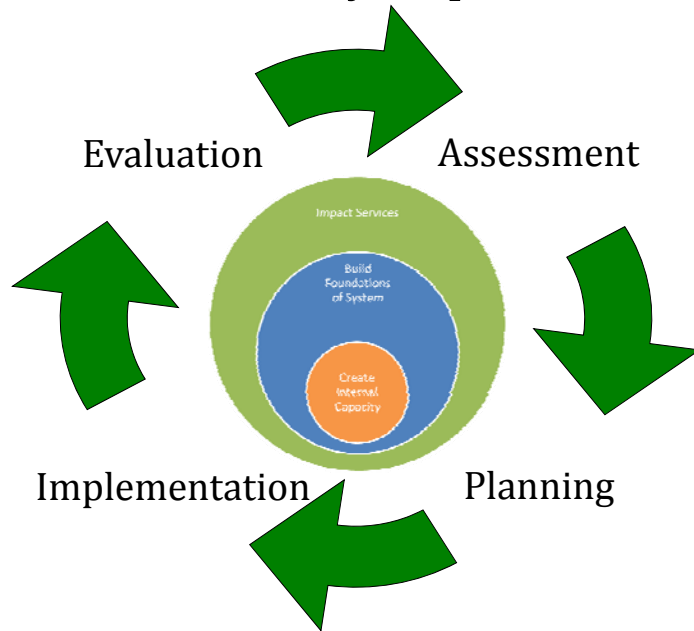

Continuous Quality Improvement Cycle



Stage	Why Collect Data?
Assessment	To inform decision making about what local early childhood system needs are
Planning	Utilize assessment, systems and resource data to support a realistic plan
Implementation	To track progress in implementing the plan. Monitor process and quality of the implementation
Evaluation	To determine what worked? Progress in meeting goals? Inform future assessment and planning processes



“Speed Data-ing”

- Round 1 – 5 minute brainstorm of data that you might need during this stage
- Round 2 – 3 minutes, move to the next chart, review and add to the brainstorm
- Round 3 – 1 minute, move to the next chart, review and add to the brainstorm
