OBJECTIVES:

- To disseminate information to caregivers statewide using television and electronic media through a partnership with KCET in Los Angeles and Rocky Mountain PBS.
- To establish relationships with early childhood partners statewide to support outreach, planning & implementation of the project
- To develop a statewide pool of trainers to deliver workshops for parents/informal caregivers based on materials and topics developed by Institute staff and by KCET ("A Place of Our Own/Los Niños en Su Casa").
- To deliver at least 48 workshops annually to parents & informal caregivers statewide.


