# TRANSITION

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- ✘ TCAP
- ✘ Assessing the overlap of the old and new standards
- ✘ No grade level shifts
- ✘ New state assessment will be piloted in 2013 and roll out in 2014
- ✘ Plans are for new assessment to be done electronically

# CONSEQUENCES FOR LOST TESTS

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- ✘ Compliance Issue in Monitoring
- ✘ Additional Training of all Proctors by CDE
- ✘ Submit Plan for Chain of Custody
- ✘ Tracking Document for Delivery and Pick up of Tests
- ✘ Submit Documentation if Test(s) is Missing
- ✘ Drop in Verification Visit

# CHAIN OF CUSTODY PROTOCOL

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- ✘ SAC stores tests in secure location
- ✘ Counts tests for grade and subject area needed
- ✘ Delivers test to classroom
- ✘ Teacher/Proctor count tests
- ✘ Immediately after testing session SAC picks tests up – SAC and Proctor verify numbers
- ✘ Assessment materials are returned to secure location

# CHANGES FOR 2012

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- ✘ Mark all accommodations used
- ✘ Don't erase stray marks – make no changes to student test materials after assessment
- ✘ Restricted Accommodations – only available to special education students with certain disabilities
