- No grade level shifts
- New state assessment will be piloted in 2013 and roll out in 2014
- Plans are for new assessment to be done electronically

#### **CONSEQUENCES FOR LOST TESTS**

- Compliance Issue in Monitoring
- Additional Training of all Proctors by CDE
- Submit Plan for Chain of Custody
- Tracking Document for Delivery and Pick up of Tests
- Submit Documentation if Test(s) is Missing
- Drop in Verification Visit

## CHAIN OF CUSTODY PROTOCOL

- **× SAC** stores tests in secure location
- Counts tests for grade and subject area needed
- Delivers test to classroom
- \* Teacher/Proctor count tests
- Immediately after testing session SAC picks tests up – SAC and Proctor verify numbers
- Assessment materials are returned to secure location

## **CHANGES FOR 2012**

- \* Mark all accommodations used
- Don't erase stray marks make no changes to student test materials after assessment
- Restricted Accommodations only available to special education students with certain disabilities
