District Leadership

- Determining if school leaders have capacity and training needed to support the implementation of the practices found in study
- Self-examination of own knowledge base about effective use of resources
- Use information from study and website to develop or revise a walkthrough tool

School Leadership

- Self-assess own knowledge base of available resources and effective use of resources

Teachers
