Subject: Notification of ELPA 90% Allocation for School Year 2008-2009

The State Board of Education approved fiscal year 2008-2009 English Language Proficiency Act (ELPA) allocations on January 14, 2009. The Colorado Department of Education will mail Districts' 90% allotment check on January 23, 2009. The remaining 10% will be distributed to school districts in June, 2009. The allocations are to be used to defray the cost of education of English Language Learners. The goals of the program are to increase the English language proficiency and academic performance of eligible students.
