A commitment to facilitate is required!

Facilitator requirements:

- Background or endorsement in gifted education
- Masters degree in some field

Facilitator expectations:

- Attend Training of Trainers session for each course.
- Facilitators will be asked to offer at least one of the two courses within the next twelve months.
- Time commitment varies depending on the course being facilitated.
- Facilitators should anticipate spending about 2 hours per week for a full roster of participants in the class they facilitate.
- Facilitator compensation is the decision of the local district or BOCES sponsoring the online professional development experience.



Training details:

The day will be spent learning the technical aspects of the on-line platform along with the content offered in selected courses. This is to assure that facilitators are aware of the quality of responses, product and criteria requirements the course designers intended.
