Review of DRAFT Rural Definition in Colorado - Jhon Penn, CDE

- The Rural Definition was presented in DRAFT form to the group
 - Definition developed by looking at and blending the current definitions for 'town' and 'rural'
 - o If a district met this new definition you were considered 'rural'
- The group that developed this definition elected to divide rural further and developed 'small rural'
 - o Recommended a cut point of 1000 students
 - o Helps to define school districts with single school (s)
- FEEDBACK NEEDED:
 - O Does it look like we are capturing a concise definition?
 - O Does the list make sense in terms of districts typically perceived as rural?
- Initial reactions from the council
 - Has there been conversation on the differences between school districts with 1000v 160 students?
 - Yes, the group did discuss this and felt the best cut point was 1000 students
 - o Agreed this is a good and reasonable definition
 - o Definition addresses geographic isolation
 - o Review is needed of definition on a 5 yr cycle to consider revisions.
- Questions to address at our October Meeting during deeper discussion of this definition
 - o How does this address large districts with smaller attendance centers?
 - Does this lead to a legislative change?
 - How can we gain recognition of definition at some level? What level is appropriate?
