Teaching & Learning Conditions Colorado

- This is the fifth iteration of Colorado’s educator survey
- Schools and districts must have more than 50% participation and at least five responses to access their data
- The TLCC will ask questions about
 - Instructional support
 - Professional development
 - Leadership
 - Facilities and resources
 - Family and community support
 - Managing student conduct
 - Future employment plans

WHAT:	Anonymous, confidential survey for school-based staff to share their perceptions of teaching and learning conditions. It is intended to support school, district and state improvement planning and inform research and policy.
WHO:	All school-based staff (teachers and building leadership) across Colorado
WHEN:	January 24th – February 23rd, 2018
WHERE:	Online, any time during the survey window, using unique codes mailed to schools

New shorter survey!

To increase relevancy, the survey administration has been adjusted for the 2018 administration, including a new vendor (Cambridge Education) and distribution process. Highlights include:

- Survey time has been reduced from 30 minutes to about 15 minutes and it can be completed in several sessions and on any device
- Questions have been updated to reflect current issues
- Survey results remain comparable over time

Overview

Initiated through HB08-1384, the Teaching and Learning Conditions in Colorado (TLCC) Survey is a statewide survey of school-based staff (teachers and building leadership) on their perceptions of the teaching and learning conditions in their schools.

The main purposes of the TLC Colorado Survey are to:

- Amplify Educators Voice
- Deepen School Improvement Efforts
- Strengthen Research and Policy
