Overview

Initiated through House Bill 08-1384, the Teaching and Learning Conditions in Colorado (TLCC) Survey is a statewide survey of teachers and building leadership on their perceptions of the teaching and learning conditions in their schools.

The main purposes of the TLC Colorado Survey are to:

- Amplify educators voice
- Deepen school improvement efforts
- Strengthen research and policy
