

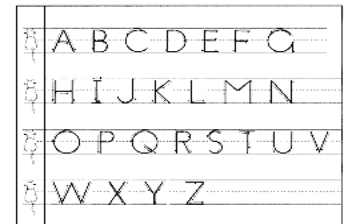

### THINGS TO REMEMBER

**Upper case letters** also are called **capital letters**. All sentences, proper names, and important words in titles must begin with an upper case letter.

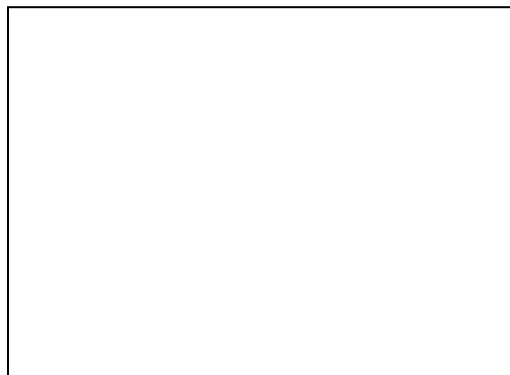
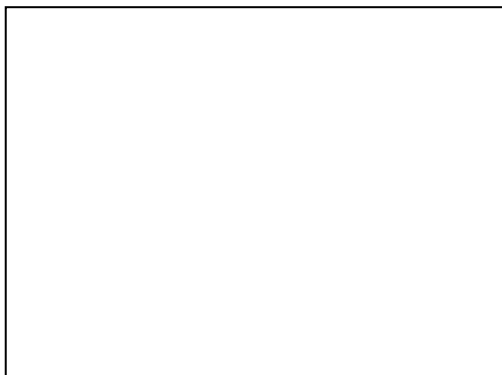
