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Purpose of UIP Reviews

Compliance:

- SB 163: Review of all Turnaround and Priority Improvement Schools and Districts
- Accountability:
 READ Act, Gifted Ed, State
 Graduation and Completion
 plans, Federal (Title IA, IIA,
 and III) improvement plans
- Specific grant programs: e.g.
 School Improvement Funds

Support:

Provide specific feedback
 on UIP Quality Criteria to
 improve quality of
 improvement planning in
 schools and districts



Purpose of Technical Assistance Trainings

The purpose of Technical Assistance is to:

- Respond to needs identified through the UIP review process
- Provide targeted improvement planning support based on the UIP feedback



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Updates and Changes in 2015 Feedback

- **1.** Feedback form now includes last year's feedback, where applicable (years 2-5)
 - Ratings for addressing last year's feedback: Yes/No/Partially

2. Restructured format

- Organized by the 4 main questions based on the Quality Criteria
 - 1. Investigates the most critical performance areas and prioritizes the most urgent performance challenges;
 - 2. Identifies root causes that explain the magnitude of the performance challenges;
 - 3. Identifies research-based major improvement strategies that have a likelihood to eliminate the root causes; and
 - 4. Presents a well-designed plan for implementing the major improvement strategies to bring about dramatic improvement.
- 3. Quality Criteria detail has been removed
- 4. Intentional streamlining of the feedback form into the most critical areas with actionable feedback.



New Expectations in UIPs Included:

READ Act requirements in the Data Analysis, Target Setting, and Action Plan steps sections

Final feedback categories:

- Required changes for April 15, 2015- Public Posting Concerns, missing plan elements, and/or Turnaround requirements
- Required for re-review for June 30, 2015
 - Schools at the end of the clock, plan will be facing more external review
- Required for 2015-16 review (January 15, 2016), if submitting to CDE
- Recommended changes only



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Overall Themes from 2015 Feedback

Re-review themes include:

- Schools in years 4 and 5
- Overall weak plan and/or missing elements
- Previous required changes were not addressed
- Turnaround requirements were not addressed
- Overall magnitude was not reflected in the plan

Required changes themes include:

Schools in years 1-3

- Family Engagement strategies: <u>http://www.cde.state.co.us/uip/trainingmaterials</u>
- Plan elements did not meet quality criteria
- Example: Priority Performance Challenges based on adult needs
