## **Instructions to the School**

Consent must be obtained when a request for the English Learner Time and One-Half (50%) Support is submitted electronically (via SSD Online) through school documentation consistent with district policy. Or, this Consent Form may be used as an alternate method to obtain consent. Consent shall be retained by the School. This form or alternative evidence of consent does not need to be submitted to the College Board. When submitting the request for supports, the school's SSD Coordinator will be asked to verify that a signed Consent Form is on file at the school and certify that the English Learner Time and One-Half (50%) Support is only being requested for those students who, at the time of testing:

• Use the same supports on school-work and other assessments, including state assessments.

- Meet the definition of "English learner" as defined by the state in which their enrolled school is located, or absent a state definition, federal policy as defined in ESSA.
- Are enrolled in an elementary or secondary school located in the U.S. or U.S. territories.
- Will only use the English Learner Time and One-Half (50%) Support for the specified tests.

### **Required Student Data for Requests**

College Board requires the following demographic data for all English Learner Time and One-Half (50%) Support requests: name, date of birth, expected high school graduation date, gender, current school, and student mailing address. In addition, the school is asked to provide the following required information regarding the student:

- Intended College Board tests
- Confirmation that the school has obtained parental consent to submit a request for the English Learner

- Identification of the EL support being requested: English Learner Time and One-Half (50%) Support
- Certification that the student
