General Questions to Ask During Visit

School Culture

- 1. Describe your school's mission and vision. How would you describe your school's culture?
- 2. How does the school monitor student and staff culture on a regular basis?
- 3. What systems has the school established to foster positive behavior? What is most challenging about your system?
- 4. How does this school support students who have academic, social or emotional difficulties?
- 5. What systems do you have to communicate with parents and families? How do you keep parents informed about their students' academic progress?

Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment

- 1. Describe the curriculum materials you use in ELA and math? What intervention programs do you use?
- 2. What assessments does the school use to monitor student progress? How frequently?
- 3. What have been your biggest strengths/challenges in using assessment to drive instruction?

Talent Management

- 1. What professional development opportunities do teachers have? In what ways do teachers collaborate?
- 2. What professional development do you provide to teachers before the start of the school year?
- 3. Describe your teacher recruitment process. Describe strategies you use to retain your most effective teachers.
- 4. Describe your system of teacher leadership.
- 5. Describe your system of information teacher observations/coaching.

Operations

- 1. Describe your annual school calendar how much time is dedicated to teacher collaboration and professional development?
- 2. Describe your school day how much time is dedicated to literacy and math instruction? What specials/enrichment/intervention opportunities are there for students?
