

Hello Superintendents and Accountability Contacts --

This communication is to let you know that your preliminary performance framework reports are now available in the Accountability Contact folder within Syncplicity. Specifically, they are available within the '2023 Preliminary Reports' subfolder located within the 'Prelim\_2023\_Frameworks folder'.

***All 2023 Preliminary Performance Framework information is embargoed until August 29.***

A resource guide has been attached to provide additional details and resources. Of note, we have added a brief description of statewide trends for the 2023 Preliminary Performance Frameworks (starting on p. 4). This can be helpful as you review your preliminary data and provide some context as you review your own local trends.

The purpose of these preliminary reports is to provide you with an overview of your schools' and district's performance based on statewide measures. In addition to other local measures of performance, these statewide measures and accountability reports can provide actionable information as you continue to prepare students to graduate ready for college and careers. Note that these framework reports are intended to inform the accreditation plan type and have implications for future work (e.g., improvement planning, grant eligibility). The reports are considered *preliminary* as there is still work to do before finalization. **All** districts must complete the Accreditation Form (available in the Accreditation Portal within the [UIP/ACI online system](#)) by **September 22** to indicate their agreement with the district and school plan types, or to indicate intention to participate in request to reconsider. In some cases, districts may need to supply additional evidence that influences school plan types and district accreditation ratings. If this is the case, we will work with your district through the [request to reconsider process](#) to determine if the district is eligible for a change in rating.

There are key resources that provide information about the preliminary 2023 school and district transitional frameworks:

- A memo that outlines more details on accessing the framework reports and reminders about next steps and contact information for staff.
- The [2023 Changes Document](#) describes changes and considerations for 2023 accountability (e.g., frameworks, UIP, ESSA identifications)

The preliminary ratings will be available publicly on the [performance framework results](#) webpage at the end of the day on Tuesday, August 29. As a courtesy to other districts as they prepare for the release of their preliminary ratings, we ask that you refrain from releasing your frameworks publicly until August 29. You may choose to share the preliminary results publicly with your local board, media or others at that time. In the meantime, we do ask that you keep the results internal to your schools/district.
