Survey Response Overview


576 educators, parents, and other members of the public responded to the survey over the nearly five-week period.

- The public comment survey was open from March 27 April 28
- The survey recorded over 1,800 responses, including blank responses or responses that only included demographic information
- For purposes of our analysis, we only reviewed responses that answered a question beyond the demographic information (i.e., offering qualitative feedback, sharing a resource, indicating an interest in being contacted by the Task Force if invited, and/or wanting to join a CDE listserv to stay up to date on the Task Force's work)
- With this criteria in place, our n-size for survey responses is 576


Who responded?

Most survey respondents were educators from the central area of the state — in suburban districts.

Question: As it relates to the education system, on what part(s) of the state do you primarily focus your attention?



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
Question: As it relates to the education system, are there particular types of districts in which you primarily focus?




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
Grades 3-8 was the most common grade level respondents focused on.
