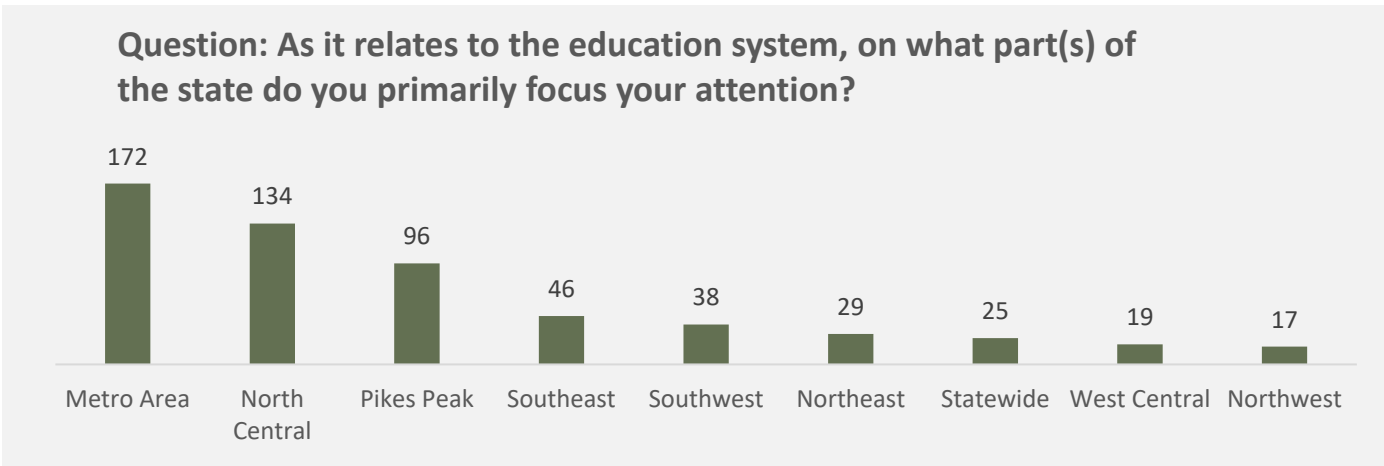
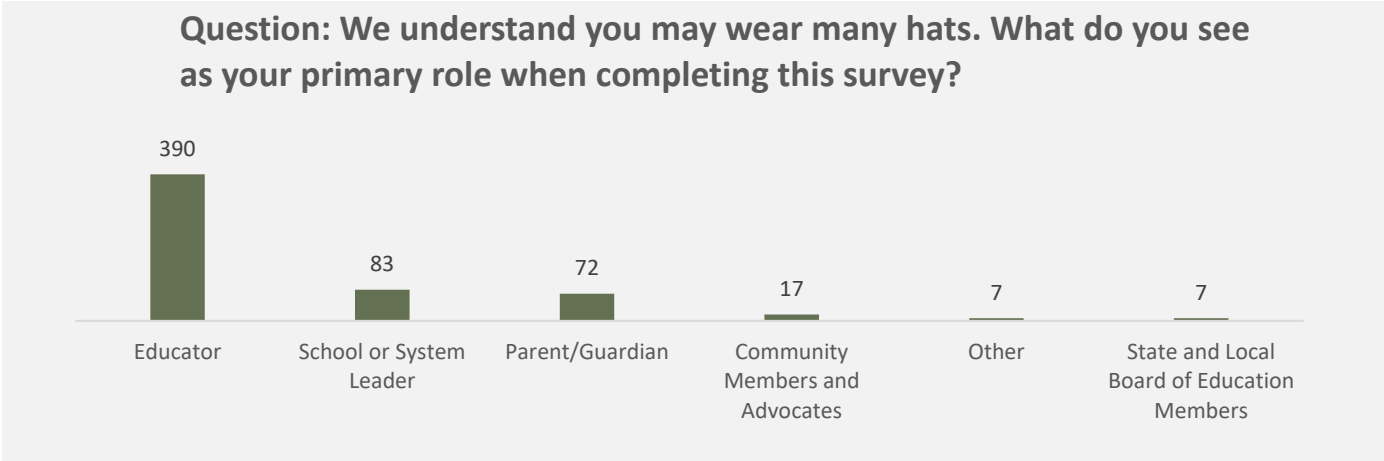
# Survey Response Overview

576 educators, parents, and other members of the public responded to the survey over the nearly five-week period.

- The public comment survey was open from March 27 – April 28
- The survey recorded over 1,800 responses, including blank responses or responses that only included demographic information
- For purposes of our analysis, **we only reviewed responses that answered a question beyond the demographic information** (i.e., offering qualitative feedback, sharing a resource, indicating an interest in being contacted by the Task Force if invited, and/or wanting to join a CDE listserv to stay up to date on the Task Force’s work)
- With this criteria in place, **our n-size for survey responses is 576**

# Who responded?

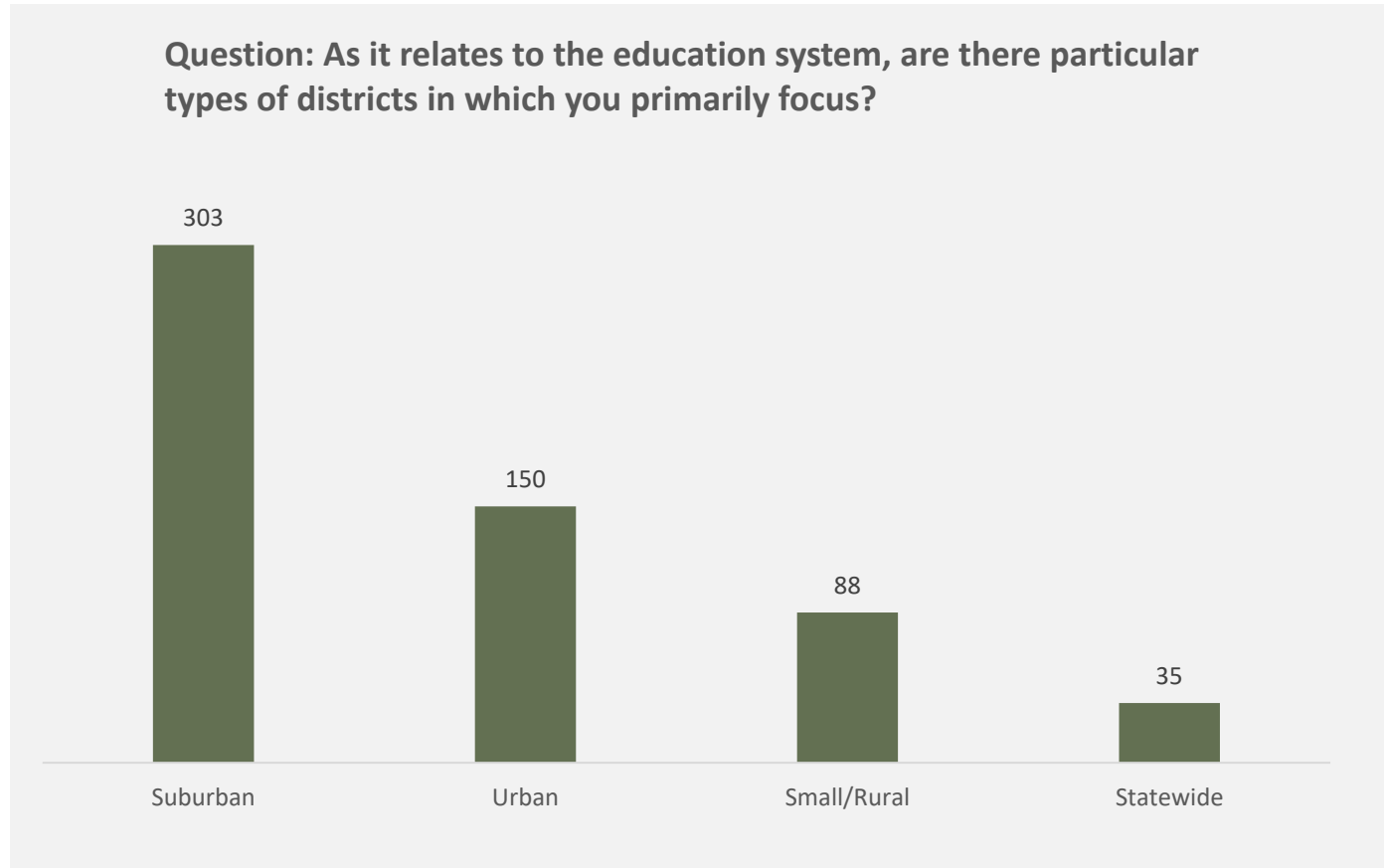
Most survey respondents were educators from the central area of the state – in suburban districts.



N=576

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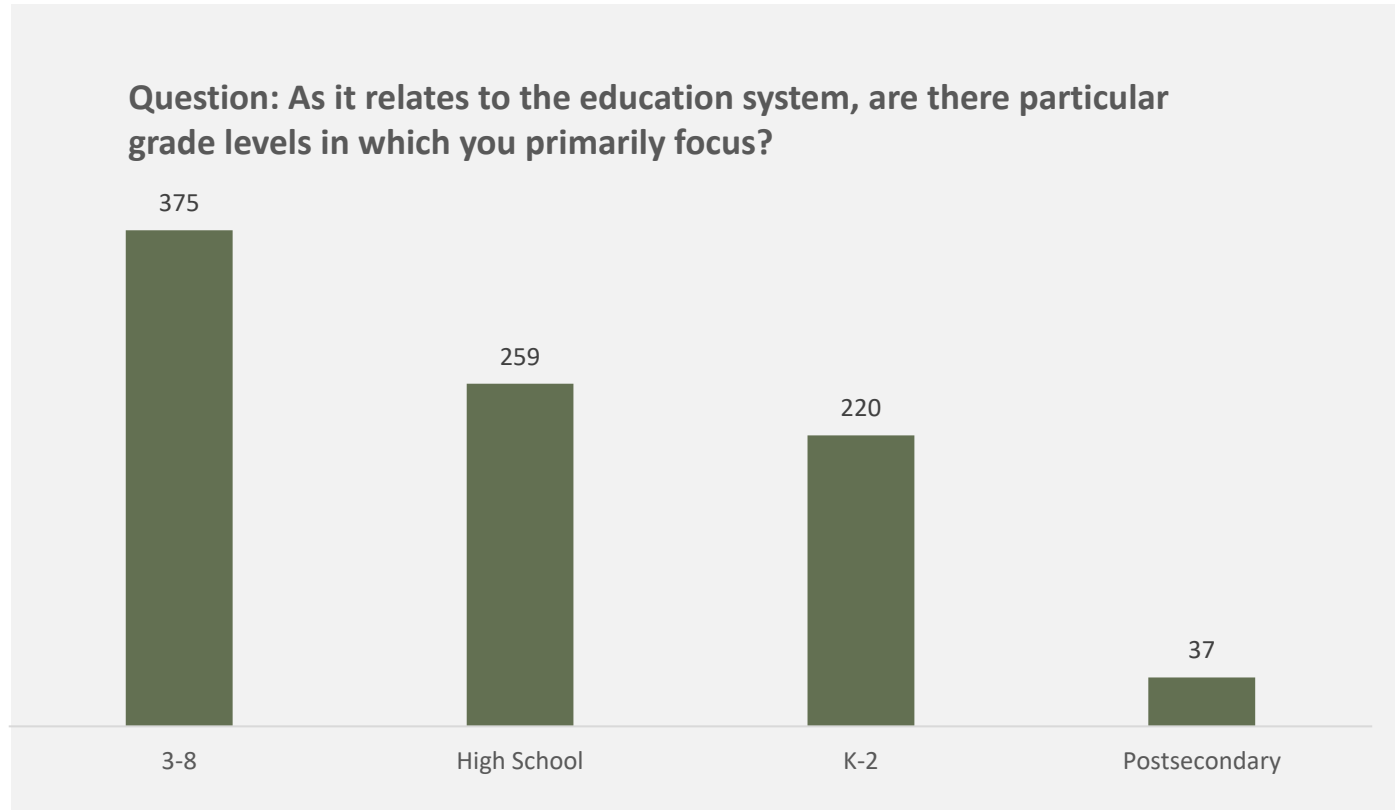
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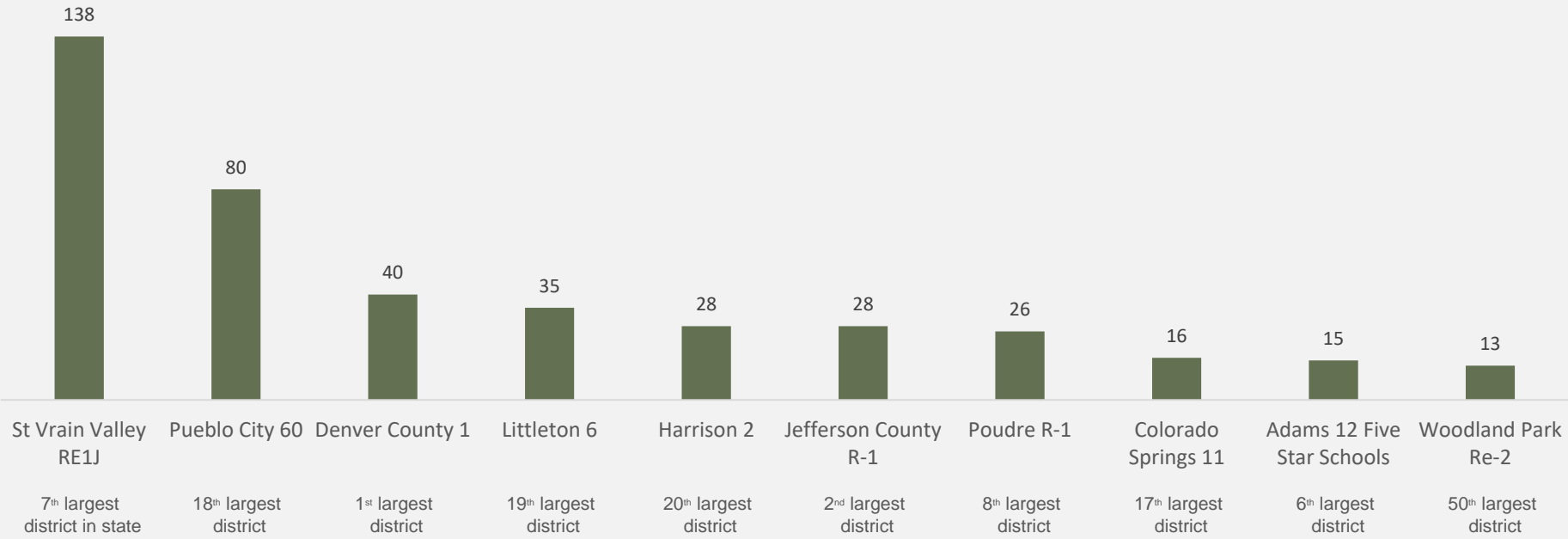
Grades 3-8 was the most common grade level respondents focused on.

# Who responded? The majority of responses were connected to these 10 districts (with 51 districts represented in total responses).
