Program Overview	<p>The Relay Graduate School of Education Instructional Leadership Professional Development (ILPD) program is a selective* national instructional school leadership program designed to increase alignment and build capacity of a principal's instructional leadership team. The program offers a practice-based curriculum providing practical leadership training and support to for a diverse group of instructional leaders (aspiring principals, Deans of Curriculum, instructional coaches, teacher leaders) in high-need and turnaround schools in improving student learning and their school communities. Coursework is focused primarily on leading data driven instruction, observation and feedback and improving school culture. The program prepares instructional leaders to better support their teachers and implement a common framework for cultivating excellence in instructional leadership. Relay aims to increase teacher effectiveness as a result of higher-capacity leaders who provide meaningful and actionable feedback to teachers, ultimately increasing student achievement.</p> <p>*Seats will be prioritized to school systems who send vertically aligned teams to Relay's Leadership Programs (supervisors, principals, instructional team leaders).</p>
