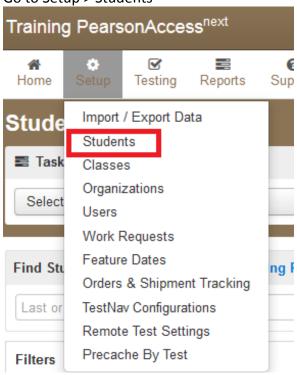
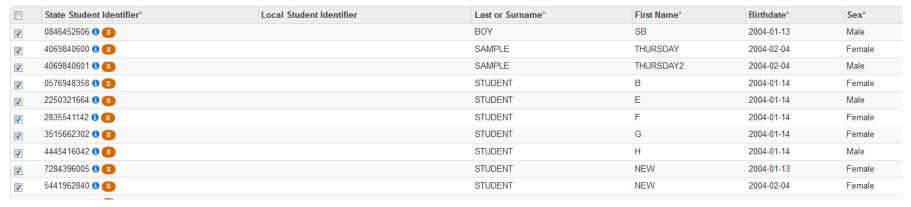
## Using the Manage Classes Task in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>

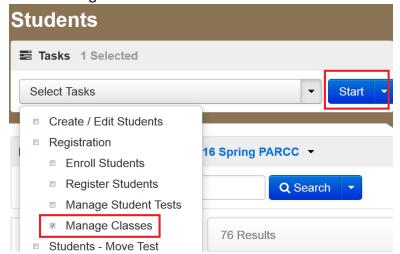
- 1. Sign in to PearsonAccessNext.
- 2. Go to Setup > Students



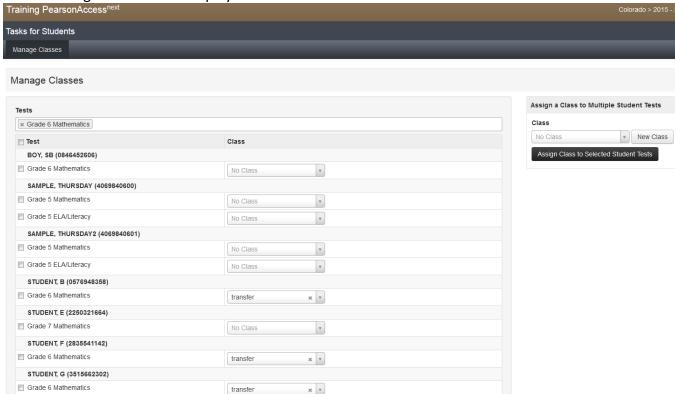
3. Locate and select the appropriate students.



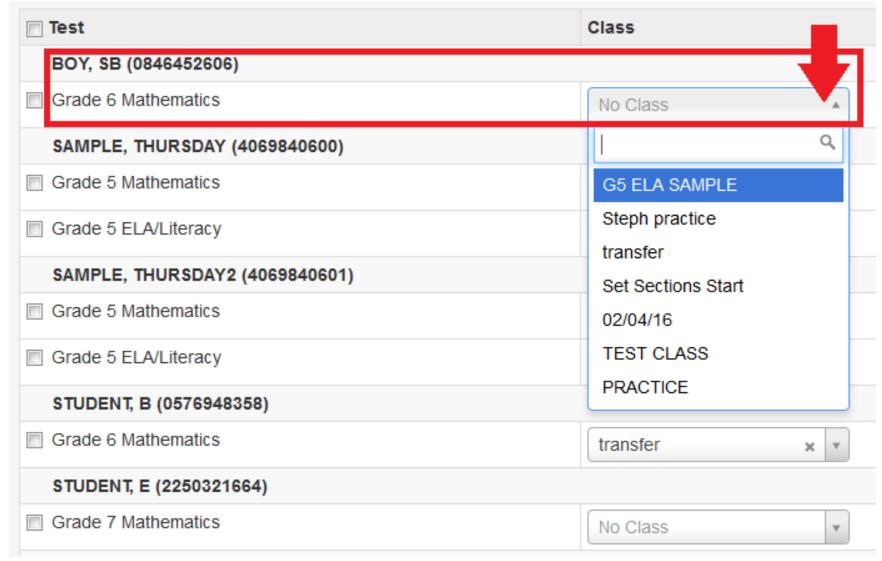
4. Select Manage Classes from the Tasks menu and select Start.



5. The following screen will be displayed:

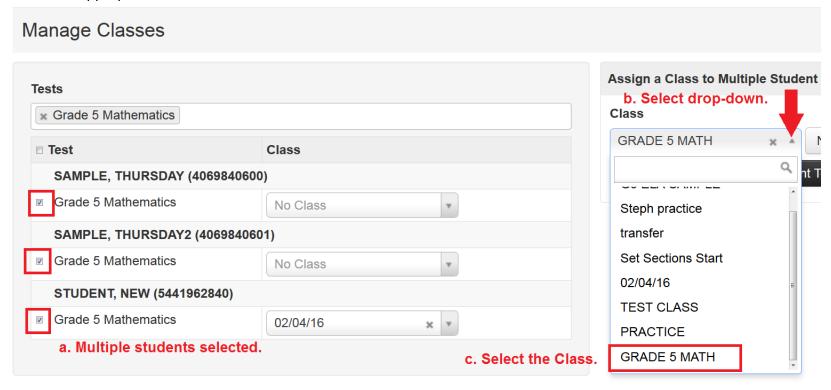


6. Classes can be updated one-by-one by selecting the drop-down menu that is in line with the student's test.

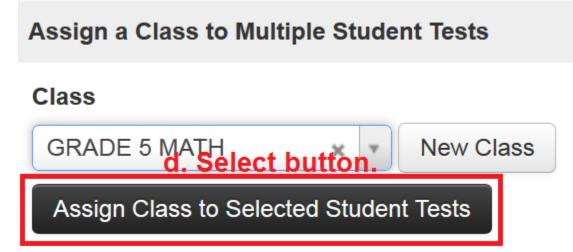


- 7. Classes can also be updated en masse by selecting multiple student tests and utilizing the "Assign a Class to Multiple Student Tests" feature:

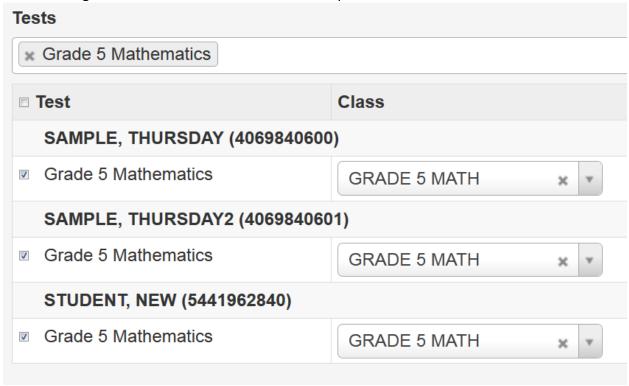
c. Select the appropriate Class name.
