

SEAL OF BILITERACY REQUIREMENTS FOR ACHS GRADUATION



The Seal of Biliteracy is an award to recognize a student who has attained proficiency in English and one or more other world languages by high school graduation. The recognition becomes part of the high school transcript and diploma. The Seal serves to certify attainment of biliteracy for students, employers, and universities. **Students must complete all requirements for graduation.**

Academic Proficiency in English	 □ Demonstrate grade level abilities in English by achieving 3.0 or above in English courses and one of the following: □ 3 or higher on AP English Language □ 3 or higher on AP English literature □ ACT English test with a score of 18 and the ACT Reading test with a score of 17 □ 4 or higher on IB English test □ 430 or higher on SAT □ Accuplacer Test R: 80-120. W; 95-120
Academic Proficiency in World Languages	Demonstrate grade level abilities in a language other than English by achieving one of the following: ☐ 3 or higher on foreign language Advanced Placement (AP) exam, including the AP Language and Culture or AP Literature and Cultures. ☐ 4 or higher on Foreign Language International Baccalaureate test ☐ Score Proficient on a World Language Exam in the District. (IF it is available)
Community Service	Participate in a total of 20 community service hours. Community service can be at school, home or community. Provide a letter from the organization(s) where your community service took place on company letterhead indicating hours worked, language(s) used, type of work, and supervisor signature or fill out the form provided by Ms. Escalante.
