2026 Teaching and Learning Conditions Colorado (TLCC) Survey

The [TLCC Survey](#) is a statewide, anonymous survey of school-based staff on their perceptions of teaching and learning conditions in our state. The survey opened today and will remain open through Monday, Feb. 23. The survey is done in collaboration with our department, the Colorado Education Association, Colorado Association of School Executives, Colorado Association of School Boards, the Colorado Education Initiative, The Colorado League of Charter Schools, and the Colorado Rural Alliance. Your survey codes went to your CEA reps and site leaders last week. We have also created a [communications toolkit](#) to help you share the survey with your teams. If at least 50% of your staff participates, you will receive data reports on your results ([here is the data dashboard from 2024](#)).
