Requirements

U.S. Service Member Applicants may meet content knowledge and experience requirements as follows:

- U.S. Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy or Space Force members: three or more years' active duty
- Guard/Reserves: 10 years' experience, or five years' experience with 12 months active-duty deployment
- Military Occupational Specialty (MOS), time of service and an honorable discharge must be verified on a DD-214 member copy 4 (submitted in application)

All other applicants must meet content knowledge and occupational requirements outlined below:

Content Knowledge:

- Hold a valid Colorado teacher license with any secondary (7-12) endorsement, a valid CTE authorization or valid Special Services license with a school counselor, school psychologist or school social worker endorsement AND
- Demonstrate six (6) semester hours of related postsecondary coursework from a regionally accredited institution verified on an official transcript, with at least three (3) semester hours in *each* of the areas on the table below <u>OR</u> hold certification as one of the following:
 - **O** Global Career Development Facilitator
 - **O** ASCA Career Development Specialist
 - **O** NCDA Certified School Career Development Advisor

Occupational Experience:

Credit for student teaching (up to 800 hours) in the content area may be applied to fulfill this requirement.

• 2,000 hours of verified occupational experience in the content area. Hours may include work as a CTE instructor, secondary educator, school counselor, school social worker, school psychologist, career/academic advisor, career pathway counselor, job placement specialist or school or district administrator.
