Movement, technique and performance (6 semester hours) e.g., Developmental movement, theatrical dance, modern, ballet, jazz, pedagogical theory, physical education movement, dance production techniques			
Create, compose, and choreograph (6 semester hours) e.g., Improvisation, choreography, music for dance, teaching and appreciating choreography			
Historical and cultural context (6 semester hours) e.g., Folk dance, social dance, ethnic dance, culturally specific dance forms, dance history			
Reflect, connect, respond (3 semester hours) e.g. Dance aesthetics and criticism, philosophy of dance, dance integration, rhythmic analysis, dance theory, Laban movement analysis			
Dance science, health, safety (3 semester hours) e.g., Anatomy, developmental movement, physiology, kinesiology, preventing dance injuries
