**1. For entry into an approved, Colorado alternative program/early childhood education:** All individuals must demonstrate content competency in the following way:

**A.** A bachelor's or higher degree from a regionally accredited college/university **AND** a passing score on one of the following exams:

- PRAXIS #5024 / 160 **OR**
- PRAXIS #5901 series (PRAXIS 5003, 5004 & 5005 also accepted)

**2. To complete a Colorado alternative program and to qualify to advance to an initial teacher license:**

**A.** All individuals who entered the program with PRAXIS #5024 must achieve a passing score on the following exam:

- PRAXIS #5205 / 159

**B.** All individuals who entered the program with PRAXIS #5901\* (or PRAXIS 5003, 5004 & 5005) must achieve passing scores on the following exams:

- PRAXIS #5024 / 160 — to meet ECE (ages 0 to 8) endorsement requirements — **AND**
- PRAXIS #5205 / 159

*\*At the time of application for an initial teacher license/early childhood education, these individuals may also request to be evaluated for an elementary (grades K to 6) endorsement, for which they would qualify based on having passed the PRAXIS #5901 (or PRAXIS 5003, 5004 & 5005) exam.*
