

2013-2014 Student October Snapshot

Purpose:

The purpose of the Student October Snapshot is to determine funding for districts and schools by taking a count of students in attendance on the Pupil Enrollment Date.

Dependencies:

Student has been assigned a SASID and updated in the RITS system.

Student has a record in the student interchange for:

- Demographics
- Student School Association
- Advanced Course Completion - This file is required if the district offers post secondary courses. Enrollment in the post secondary courses must be recorded in the Student October collection for funding purposes.

Student has a record in the Title 1 interchange if:

- Student has received Targeted Assisted (TA) Services/Funding (as of Oct. 1)

Criteria for inclusion in the Student October snapshot:

Pull all error-free records from the Student School Association file that match the following criteria:

- PRIMARY_SCHOOL = '1' **AND**
- SCHOOL_ENTRY_DATE <= pupil's count date for the current school year **AND**
- SCHOOL_EXIT_DATE is null **OR** SCHOOL_EXIT_DATE >= pupil's count date for the current school year **AND**
- If the calculated age as of pupil enrollment date of the reporting school year >= 2 and <= 21 **OR** If the calculated age as of pupil enrollment date of the reporting school year <=21 and LEA code is in list of schools with waivers **OR** If PRIMARY_DISABILITY (from student table) <> '00' then calculated age as of December 31 of the reporting school year <= 21

The records selected will be joined with data from the Student and Advanced Course Completion tables.

- For joining to Student, use District Code, School Year, and SASID.
- For joining to Advanced Course Completion, use District Code, School Code, School Year, and SASID



NOTE: The application will allow districts to indicate they are using October 1st or November 1st for the pupil count date for preschool students (ENTRY_GRADE_LEVEL = '004'). All other grade levels will use pupil enrollment date (October 1st).

Note: The primary key () for the Student October Snapshot aligns with the primary key for the Student Interchange – Student School Association File

Federal Race Student

Federal Race/Ethnicity Reporting Category - the single category used to classify the student or staff member in aggregated federal or state reporting such as pupil counts, graduation rates, and assessment results. This designation is based on the race and ethnicity information provided to the reporting district by the student (or his or her parent/guardian) or staff member.

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Title 1 Student

Targeted Assistance - Children that are identified by the school as failing, or most at risk of failing, to meet the State's challenging student academic achievement standards on the basis of multiple, educationally related, objective criteria established by the school, except that children from preschool through grade 2 shall be selected solely on the basis of such criteria as teacher judgment, interviews with parents, and developmentally appropriate measures. Children who are economically disadvantaged, children with disabilities, migrant children, limited English proficient (LEP) children, are eligible for services under this part on the same basis as other children selected to receive services under this part.

Schoolwide – Schoolwide (SW) reform provides opportunities for all children to meet the states' proficient and advanced levels of student academic achievement. All students in Schoolwide schools should be reported as Title 1.

Title 1 -- Student is either served in Targeted Assistance or Schoolwide Title 1 program.
