What We've Done

- Upload templates created and shared across folders with AUs
- Templates completed by AUs for Round 1 upload and shared with CDEC
- Templated data has been uploaded by CDEC into new IEP Direct Placement Reference Library
- Existing 24-25 Family applications referenced against Reference Library
- UPK team shared out an updated version of the AU technical guide on Friday, with new information on the experience of accessing your students in the UPK Admin.

What's In Progress

- Manually auditing Round 1 upload placements (since it's the first time!)
- Identifying Children in the Library for whom there is not yet a 24-25 UPK Application
- Identifying Applications where a Family has selected the child has an IEP, yet the child did not appear in the round 1 upload by AUs.
- Reaching out to the list of AUs who have engaged in the process to provide support
- Incorporating your feedback and questions into next update of the AU technical guide.
