Join us in learning how to seamlessly incorporate Person-Centered Planning into your current Secondary Transition processes.

Person-Centered Planning is a process that helps students with disabilities to plan for their future while also promoting self-determination. Participants will learn planning strategies to help students identify their dreams, strengths, preferences, interests, and needs.

Sessions will include an overview of Person-Centered Planning and opportunities to complete three plans using a variety of Charting the LifeCourse (CtLC) tools.
