SEL Through the Arts Virtual Symposium Repeated for 2021

This symposium is a **repeat** from Fall 2020 for those unable to attend at that time. Think 360 Arts and the Colorado Department of Education Standards and Instructional Support Team are joining together to share ideas about developing an understanding of SEL, identifying ways you are currently using SEL, and how you can make SEL an embedded part of your teaching practice.

This symposium will be conducted virtually in three modules:

- Module I is asynchronous and opens the week of January 25th. It will answer the question of "What is SEL and what does it mean to my students and myself?"
- Module II is asynchronous and opens in early February. It will offer exciting presentations by an array of amazing teaching artists. A variety of engaging approaches to arts and SEL will be shared. Artists include: Jennifer Johnson Lowe, Kristina Maldonado Bad Hand, Eileen Roscina Richardson, Lainie Hodges, and The Queenz of Hip Hop.
- Module III will be synchronous small group content specific discussions on how you are incorporating SEL competencies in your unique practice. These will be held late February through early March and you will sign up for a time that fits your schedule.

Colorado Academic Standards Review and Revision

The office of Standards and Instructional Support is seeking applications for review and revision committee membership in Social Studies, Dance, Drama/Theatre Arts, Music, and Visual Arts. During the 2020 legislative session, the General Assembly passed Colorado House Bill 20-1032 (section 22-7-1005(6) C.R.S) amending the provision that required all content area revisions to occur within six years of the prior cycle which occurred in 2018. The changes now require the state board to review and revise approximately one-third of the standards beginning in 2022 and an additional one-third every two years thereafter.
