<b>Phonemic Awareness</b>	The ability to hear, identify, and manipulate individual phonemes in spoken words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First Sound Fluency (FSF)</li> <li>• Phoneme Segmentation Fluency (PSF)</li> </ul>
<b>Phonics</b>	The system of letter-sound relationships that is the foundation for decoding words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nonsense Word Fluency (NWF)</li> <li>• DIBELS® Oral Reading Fluency (DORF)</li> </ul>
<b>Accurate and Fluent Reading of Connected Text</b>	The ability to read a text accurately and quickly with automaticity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DIBELS® Oral Reading Fluency (DORF)</li> </ul>
<b>Reading Comprehension</b>	The process of an intentional interaction between reader and text to convey meaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DIBELS® Oral Reading Fluency (DORF)</li> <li>• DAZE</li> </ul>
