

Spring Data Collection

Our goal is to create flexibility for districts when possible while remaining consistent with the intent of the law.


Spring Data Collection

- The department will not collect spring reading assessment data and instead will base per pupil intervention funding for the 2020-21 school year on 2019-20 information.
- The new budget/narrative process is due on June 30, 2020.
- Governor Polis issued an executive order suspending the 15% carryover provision for the 2019-2020 school year.
 - CDE will review carryover funds separately from the budget/narrative process.

Assessment for Evidence-Based Teacher Training



State Board of Education approved a test that teachers may take to demonstrate their understanding of evidence-based reading instruction, a requirement of the changes to the READ Act approved by the legislature last year.

- Test selected: [Educational Testing Service's \(ETS\) Praxis Teaching Reading Elementary \(5205\)](#)
- Teachers will need to score at least 159 on the assessment
- ETS is currently closed due to COVID-19

Advisory List Updates

The Spring 2020 review process has been interrupted due to COVID-19.

- At this time CDE has reviewed about 80% of the programs submitted.
- All English core programs have been reviewed and are reflected on the provided list.
- Vendors who submitted programs that have been reviewed and not approved were notified and have been provided information regarding the appeal process (CCE 301-92, 11.02).
- The remaining programs to be reviewed are primarily Spanish language programs requiring bilingual reviewers, which may impact our review time frame. However, several English supplemental and intervention program still need to be reviewed.

Moving Forward

- CDE will work hard to continue to review the programs that were not completed. Due to the volume of reviews, it is unlikely we can meet our original expected completion timeframe.
- Once all programs have been reviewed and after the appeal process, additional programs may be posted.
- Review material templates will be posted (e.g. rubric templates, applications)
- CDE will solicit support from the field to finalize reviews
- Stakeholders may request rubrics of reviewed programs once the list is finalized.
 - To assess local next steps
 - To seek guidance from the department

Evidence-Based Training in Teaching Reading

The READ Act | C.R.S. 22-7-1208 (6)(a)(b)

Each district that receives READ funding must ensure all K – 3 teachers have completed evidence-based training in teaching reading by the beginning of the 2021-22 school year.

- Successfully completed evidenced-based training in teaching reading if the LEP submits evidence that the teacher:
- Successfully completed a CDE-provided reading training designed to meet this training requirement and passed the end of course assessment of learning; or
- Passed a CDE-approved undergraduate or graduate reading course and passed the end of course assessment of learning; or 1
- Passed a CDE-approved district or BOCES reading course or a course appropriate for license renewal and passed the end of course assessment of learning; or
- Holds a state of Colorado endorsement as a Reading Teacher or Reading Specialist; or
- Successfully completed a training program included on the department’s advisory list of professional development programs created pursuant to C.R.S. § 22-7-1209(2)(c) and passed the end of course assessment of learning.
- In the event that a teacher completes one of the evidence-based training options listed in 13.01(C)(2) but lacks proof of passing an end of course assessment, the teacher may take and pass an alternate assessment authorized by the State Board aligned to the expectations of this section.




Consideration if choosing the K-3 Training provided by the CDE

- Online Training
 - Program selected for online training: **Public Consulting Group (PCG)**
 - Contract development in process
 - The online training may be available by summer depending upon delays.
- Face to Face Training
 - Program selected for face to face training: **Keys to Literacy**
 - Contract development in process
 - We anticipate the scheduling of the face to face training will be delayed due to COVID-19.

No cost includes the follow:

- Training
 - including license and registration if required
- All required training materials
- Trainer


Preschool through 3rd Grade Office Hours


