How to Score and Calculate WCPM

When listening to a student read aloud, the teacher or partner will draw a line under each word read incorrectly on their own copy of the text.

- If the student skips a line, the line is crossed out and the number of words on that line is subtracted from the total number of words read.
- If the student self corrects, you will write the letter "SC" above the word and not count it as a word read incorrectly.
- At the end of the timed reading, circle the last word read.
