When will tests be given?

CMAS Tests

CMAS tests in science, social studies, English language arts/literacy and math will be administered in one window from **April 8-26, 2019**. All elementary and middle school social studies and science tests must be scheduled and completed during the April 8-26 testing window. Districts may request an early window to administer the high school science test as early as March 25. Districts may also request an extended test window for math and ELA, only for online testing, due to limited device availability as early as March 18.

College Board's High School Assessments

Colorado's ninth- and 10th-grade students will continue to take the PSAT, and 11th-grade students will take the SAT. The 2019 test date for the SAT will be **April 9, 2019**. Districts will have a choice of **April 9, April 10 or April 11, 2019**, as the test date for the PSAT for ninth- and 10th-graders.
