Core Credits Earned at Time of Entry - The core credits earned at year of entry into the AEC. This field is used to determine if a student is Over Age and Under Credit. If data is entered in this field, data must also be entered in Core Credits Required to Graduate.

Total Credits Required To Graduate – The total number of credits the school/district requires for graduation. This field is used to determine if a student is Over Age and Under Credit.

Core Credits Required to Graduate - The total number of credits the school/district requires for graduation. This field is used to determine if a student is Over Age and Under Credit.

Over Age and Under Credit - Student is over traditional school age for their grade level and lack adequate credit hours for their grade level. This value is pre-filled based on Student Interchange data and provided for reference. Changes made to the district-identified fields will result in changes to this field on upload of data. Only high school students are eligible for this high risk category. - Pregnant or parenting: Student is under the age of twenty years and is a parent or pregnant woman.
- Mental or behavioral health issue: Student has a documented history of a mental or behavioral health issue.
- Ward of court: Student is a ward of the court.

- Experienced significant trauma: Student has experienced significant trauma.
