

Cross LEA Validation – Error SE807 and SE808 Instructions

Error SE807

Students with entry type 26 (transfer from a detention center not in district) must have a valid district detention center code (9801-9809) entered in the prior detail record (current or prior year) and must also have a different organization code in the prior detail record (note: if student is transferring from a detention center within district, use entry code 12). Recommended action: District entering the student may change entry type to reflect student's prior educational entity.

Using the information provided in the report titled **“EOY Cross LEA Edit Report”**, you will need to identify students who received this warning. CDE does not show the student attending a detention center before attending the district. The student's entry type may be changed to reflect the student's enrollment prior to attending the district. If your records clearly indicate the student was previously enrolled in a detention center you do not need to change your records. Please contact CDE if you are unsure of the student's location before attending the district and would like to update the student's enrollment history.

Error SE808

Students with Exit Type 26 and school code other than 980x should be followed by record with Entry Type Code 13 in school code 980x. Recommended action: District exiting student with 26 may change the exit type to reflect student movement.

Using the information provided in the report titled **“EOY Cross LEA Edit Report”**, you will need to identify students who received this warning. CDE does not show the student attending a detention center and the student's exit type needs to be changed to reflect the student's next enrollment. Please change the student's exit type to a valid value which reflects the student's location after leaving the district. Please contact CDE if you are unsure of the student's location before attending the district and would like to update the student's enrollment history. If the student has not enrolled in a Colorado public school during the school year, you may be required to change this exit type to '40' drop out unless your district provides adequate documentation of enrollment and attendance.
