CREDIT RECOVERY PROCEDURES – Under no circumstances will the original course or grade be changed in the student's transcript. In all cases in which the student is earning credit for an entire course, the original course grade will stand and the "recovered" course will be recorded as a new course. For full detail, refer to the High School **Procedures Guide.**
