

Applications Being Accepted for Facility Schools Board

The Office of Approved Facility Schools, at the Colorado Department of Education, is seeking applicants for two open seats on the Facility Schools Board. Applications for the Facility Schools Board are due February 27, 2026.

The two open seats represent:

- One person who represents State-level child placement agencies within Colorado.
- One person who represents County Departments of Social Services within Colorado

In addition, the members of the board need to be representative of the geographic areas of the state and representative of the ethnic and racial diversity and gender balance within the state.

The term of membership is three years. The board meets monthly. Members of the board serve without compensation, except for reasonable reimbursement of expenses.

The Facility Schools Board is responsible for the approval of facility schools; overseeing the adopted curriculum, assessment, and student information systems; adopting graduation requirements and awarding high school diplomas; and establishing accountability measures for approved facility schools.

Individuals meeting the qualifications for membership on the Facility Schools Board are invited to apply by submitting a personal resume along with a letter of interest. Application documents are due by February 27, 2026. Application documents can be e-mailed to: stirman_j@cde.state.co.us.
