FSCP Policy – Overview of the Law

Draft

- ESSA Section 1116(a) and (b) policy is jointly developed with and distributed to families.

Implement

- C.R.S. 22-11-302(g)(II) District Accountability Committee
- C.R.S. 22-11-402 (h)(II) School Accountability Committee

Evaluate

- ESSA Section 1116(a)(2)(D) conduct, with the meaningful involvement of parents and family members, an annual evaluation of the content and effectiveness of the parent and family engagement policy

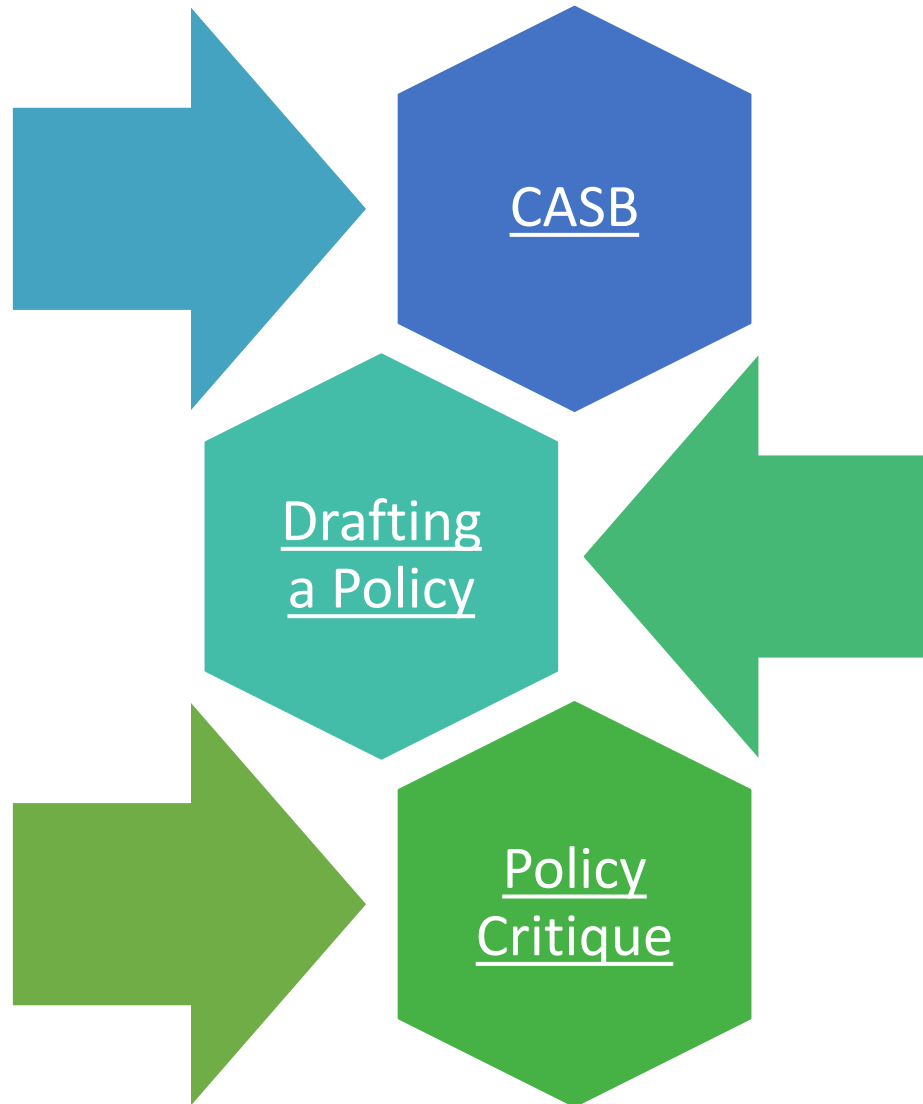
