This course is designed to provide you with:

- Examination of various types of learners in your classroom or school
- Awareness of how the learning environment & teaching style influence the success of the 2e student
- Creation of a more meaningful process using Multi-tiered System of Supports (MTSS) to support your students with gifts and challenges
- Using data to inform instructional program decisions including student strengths, student needs, potential interventions, and delivery options for 2e students
- Investigating the potential challenges 2e students face including SLD, SED, ASD, ADHD, dyslexia, dysgraphia, executive functioning and more
- Collaboration with others to further develop educational plans that will be responsive to a student's profile
- Review of resources to support dual-differentiation, rigor & strength-based programming, early access, families, & ways to spread the word

Important notes:

- Workshops are offered at no cost to participants (all materials are provided by CDE)
- Lunch is on your own. We will break for an hour on the days we meet in person.
- Successful completion of the course means the participant is eligible to earn one (1.0) graduate credit hour through Adam's State University (\$55.00), or 15 relicensure hours through CDE (free)
