

School Food Initiative Evaluation

improvements made to increase use of scratch/fresh ingredients

250

scratch/fresh ingredients added to menu cycles

28

items changed to more scratch/fresh ingredients

81% were made in the vegetable category improving salad bars

5% increase in dried herbs/spices decreases sodium preserves flavor * Evaluation results from a sample of 5 districts enrolled in the 2015-2016 school year

highly processed ingredients dropped from menu cycle


