<b>Allowable Meals</b>	Breakfast, Lunch, Afterschool snacks  May not provide weekend or holiday meal	Same
<b>Area Eligibility</b>	Meals may be provided only to children enrolled in the district	Same
<b>Reimbursement Rates</b>	<a href="#">NSLP/SBP reimbursement rates</a>	Same
<b>Meal Claiming</b>	Claim meals by student eligibility (free/reduced-price/paid)  Communicate unpaid meal charge policy to families	Same
<b>Free &amp; Reduced Price Meal Applications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must collect and process applications as part of normal operations</li> <li>• Must follow disclosure requirements, complete verification and direct certification</li> <li>• May use a student's eligibility status from the prior school year for the first 30 days of the new school year (i.e., carryover)</li> </ul>	Same, <b>except:</b> Sponsors that operated the Seamless Summer Option in SY 2021-22 and do not have eligibility information for a student on file, may use the most recent years' eligibility for student's carryover status back to SY 2019-20  No waiver required
<b>Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) Tool</b>	If sponsor has a negative balance, must complete PLE tool and increase the price of paid lunches based on tool outcome, if applicable	For SY 2022-23, sponsors are not required to increase their paid lunch prices  No waiver required
<b>Meal Pattern</b>	<a href="#">NSLP/SBP meal patterns</a>  Offer vs. serve is required for lunch at the high school level  Sponsors must plan all menus to <a href="#">meet the grade group requirements</a> for the grade groups served at each site  Pre-K students must follow the <a href="#">pre-K meal pattern</a> when eating meals separately from older students	Same, <b>except:</b> When impacted by Covid-19 offer vs. serve is not required for lunch at the high school level  A waiver is required and must be approved by CDE

<b>Meal Service Times</b>	Meals must be served during a specific time frame, duration of time, and ensure no overlap of meal service	Same, <b>except:</b> When impacted by Covid-19 varied meal service times are allowed  A waiver is required and must be approved by CDE
<b>Meal Service Location</b>	Meals must be served to students enrolled in the district and consumed on site. To increase student access to meals, meals may be served in the cafeteria, classroom or elsewhere on the school campus.	Same, <b>except:</b> When impacted by Covid-19 and approved by CDE, non-congregate feeding and parent pickup are allowed  A waiver is required and must be approved by CDE
<b>Applications</b>	Apply to operate school nutrition programs through the Child Nutrition Portal  Sponsors will apply in the 2022-23 school year and submit SNP site applications	Same
<b>Fresh Fruit &amp; Vegetable Program</b>	May apply and serve if awarded. To apply, a site must be an elementary school and operations begin at the start of the school year.	Same, <b>except:</b> When impacted by Covid-19 and approved by CDE, alternate sites and parent pick up are allowed  A waiver is required and must be approved by CDE
<b>Afterschool Snack Program</b>	May apply and serve; the site must meet eligibility requirement of 50% or more based on previous school year October count	Same, <b>except:</b> If the site does not meet eligibility requirements based on SY 2021-22, the site may use alternative options to determine site eligibility: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Option 1: <a href="#">Use SY 2019-20 October count data</a></li> <li>• Option 2: <a href="#">Use SY 2021-22 Community Eligibility Provision data</a></li> </ul> No waiver required
<b>On-Site Monitoring</b>	The <a href="#">on-site monitoring form</a> must be completed by February 1 <sup>st</sup> of each school year for each site and must take place on-site	Same, <b>except:</b> Sponsors may complete the on-site monitoring form via a desk audit  No waiver required
<b>Local Wellness Policy Triennial Assessment</b>	The local wellness policy triennial assessment is due June 30, 2022	Sponsors may complete the triennial assessment by June 30, 2023  No waiver required

**Food Service Management Companies (FSMC)**

Sponsors may contract with a FSMC for no longer than one year, with options for a yearly renewal not to exceed four additional years.

Sponsors up for a FSMC renewal may extend existing contracts through SY 2022-23
