- <u>Legislative Updates</u> Andy Tucker
 Number of bills that impact education; 2 have been signed by the Governor.
 - HB 18-1052 Exception To 2-year Higher Education Service Areas (see Legislative Updates link above for details)

- May 1st CDHE will meet with CCCS to draft procedures.
- CCCS clarification: If the service area partner offers the course that students are interested in taking, district must still use their service area partner.
- HB 18-1005 <u>Notice To Students Of Postsecondary Courses</u> (see Legislative Updates link above for details)
 - Guidance will be prepared
- SB18-225 <u>Definition Of Early College High Schools</u> (see Legislative Updates link above for details)
 - Schools currently designated will have 2 years remaining if your designation is current
 - CDE will check on bill's application to self-declared early colleges
 - CDE will check on definition of 'credential' in the law
 - CDE will check on required review date by State Board of Education
- HB18-085 Financial Incentives for Education in Rural Areas (see Legislative Updates link above for details)
 - Current Law 20 stipends
 - Proposed increase to 60 stipends not to exceed \$6,000 each
- HB18-1193 <u>Extend Advanced Placement Incentives Program</u> (see Legislative Updates link above for details)
 - For rural and small rural school districts
 - AP Incentives Extend 3 years to 2021 (same appropriation of \$1,000,000)
- Updating the <u>Recommendations for Work-Based Learning in Concurrent Enrollment</u> document. Board members were asked to review and send comments to Mary Anne Hunter in next few weeks.
- ASCENT
 - Updated guidelines and documents will be sent to board members to review and forward suggestions/changes to Mary Anne Hunter.
 - Will include wording that postsecondary courses must be transcripted, credit-bearing, college-level and that developmental/remedial course work will not count toward 12 credit hour requirement

 - O Board will receive a draft to review by Monday
 - <u>CEAB Operating Procedures Operating Manual</u>
 - O must be reviewed every 2 years by the Board
 - O Board was asked to review and provide feedback by next meeting
