### Concurrent Enrollment October Count Funding Guidelines

Part-time (PT)	2-5 HS classes* (PT) (90+ hrs/semester)		3-11 college credits (PT) <i>(Includes Career Start)</i>
Full-time (FT)	6+ HS classes* (FT) (360+ hrs/semester) <i>Can include on-campus college classes</i>	2-5 HS classes* (PT) <b><i>and</i></b> 3-11 college credits (PT) <i>(ENG121 is 3 credits)</i>	12+ college credits (FT)

*\*Assumes bell schedule and seat time calculations which require at least 6 high school classes to meet minimum 360 contact hours per semester for full-time funding and at least 2 high school classes to meet minimum 90 contact hours for part-time funding, as described on pages 13-14 of the [2018 CDE Student October Count Audit Resource Guide](#).*

*(Please confirm the number of high school classes required to meet your campus PT and FT funding requirements from your high school administration.)*

*Starting in 2017-18, CDE allows high schools to evaluate **on-campus CE college courses based on college credits or seat time** (p.22 of 2018 Student October Count Audit Resource Guide).*

*Examples:*

- ❖ ENG121(3 college credits) will meet PT funding requirements, and when combined with any PT high school schedule (2-5 HS classes), will meet FT funding requirements.*
- ❖ ENG121 can also be counted as a HS class, based on seat time, and combined with additional HS classes to meet FT funding requirements.*
