Description/Summary

The Adams 12 Office of Federal Programs provides monthly skill building sessions to family liaisons to assist in the direct work they do with families and students. Each month a different topic is focused on based on the needs of families and liaison feedback. It's the belief of this office that liaisons who are well trained are empowered to influence families/students at a high impact level.

Key Strategies

Building capacity from within each school by supporting the training of family liaisons in the Love & Logic parenting model.

Consistent monthly meetings to provide training on topics such as parenting, families living in poverty, cultural awareness, substance abuse education, customer service, creating a welcoming environment, home visits, national standards, etc.

Leveraging Title I parent set aside and Title III funds at the school and district level for certification in the Parenting and Love & Logic model, as well as other projects.
