Training Topic 1:

Understanding Stress & Trauma; Grounding in the HEARTS Model

This foundational professional learning workshop will explore trauma-informed practices grounded in the HEARTS (Healthy Environments and Response to Trauma in Schools) framework that is an equity-focused, whole-school approach that supports sustainable individual and systemic change by creating school-wide literacy of the impact of trauma, while embedding universal supports to foster resilience.

Training Topic 2:

Cultural Humility; Resilience & Social-Emotional Learning; Grief

This workshop will expand on foundational trauma-informed core concepts through the HEARTS framework, specifically focusing on Cultural Humility, Resilience, Social-Emotional Learning, and Grief. Applying practices and skills in the context of the current COVID-19 pandemic will continue to be addressed throughout the workshop.

Training Topic 3:

Safety & Predictability; Compassion & Dependability

The third and final workshop in this series will expand on trauma-informed core concepts through the HEARTS framework in the context of the current COVID-19 pandemic, specifically focusing on Creating Predictable Environments, Fostering Resilience through Connection, Creating a Trauma-Informed Classroom, and Trauma-Informed Planning for School Re-opening.
