The Denver Metro Area includes 438,136 (55.18%) of the state's total Fall 2006 student membership (794,026) in public schools. From Fall 1996 to Fall 2006 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 76,631 students (21.2%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 43,957 students (14.09%).

\* NOTE: Detention Center students were removed from the district count and pulled into a separate category. Although detention center students receive educational services from school district employees, school districts have no jurisdiction over any other detention center function.
