### THINGS TO REMEMBER

There are many good ways to get answers to questions. Sometimes, we find answers in a book, on the computer, or from a person.

Good question words ask: **WHO? WHAT? WHEN? WHERE? WHY? HOW?**

### LET'S DO THIS

1. Ask your child: Where are the places you have been in the past 2 days?

Where are other favorite places that you have been?

Draw one of your favorite places in the picture box.

2. Ask your child: **Why** is this one of your favorite places?

**When** were you there? **What** did you do there?

## LET'S FIND OUT

1. Let's play a question game.

**Who?**    **What?**    **When?**    **Where?**    **Why?**    **How?**

Ask your child: Let's take turns asking questions to learn about more about each other or someone at home.

You take the first turn. Circle one of the question words, above.

Use that word to ask your child a question such as:

What is your favorite game?

or: When do you think is the best time to do homework?

Then, your child will take a turn to circle a question word and ask you a question.

Take 3 turns each to circle all six question words, above.
